Why should I use Conqueror?

Versatile

- can be used in aquatic, amenity, horticulture, forestry and industrial situations, including on hard surfaces

Where can I use Conqueror?

Conqueror is an ultra low volume TDC herbicide. It is used to control annual and perennial grasses and perennial broad-leaved weeds. Conqueror is also a highly effective aquatic herbicide, controlling emergent and floating weeds.

You can use Conqueror in a wide range of situations, including aquatic, amenity industrial areas, forestry, parks, paved areas and highways. Conqueror is also recommended for clearing weeds prior to planting shrub and rose beds.

How does Conqueror work?

Conqueror is a ready to use, ultra low volume herbicide, containing the active ingredient glyphosate. It is quickly absorbed through the foliage, moving through the weed to the root system, ensuring fast, effective control.

The biactive formulation allows the glyphosate to penetrate into the weed, giving full control whilst applying less active ingredient. This significantly reduces the environmental impact.

How do I apply Conqueror?

Conqueror should be applied using a Nomix Total Droplet Control (TDC) applicator.

Simply shake the pack, connect it directly to the applicator, calibrate and you are ready to start spraying.

The white pigment in Conqueror makes it easy to see where it has been applied. This makes application more accurate.



Established annuals, deep-rooted perennials and broad-leaved weeds	10 litres/ha
Light vegetation and small annual weeds	7.5 litres/ha
Aquatic situations – emergent weeds such as reeds, grasses and watercress	12.5 litres/ha
Aquatic situations – floating weeds such as water lilies	15 litres/ha
