Why should I use frontSWEEP?

Effective control

- controls broad-leaved weeds, annual and perennial grasses

How does frontSWEEP work?

frontSWEEP contains Glyphosate. It is absorbed by the foliage and translocated to underground roots, rhizomes and stolons, making it highly effective.

How do I apply frontSWEEP?

frontSWEEP should be mixed with water and applied using a hand-held knapsack sprayer or a vehicle mounted boom sprayer.

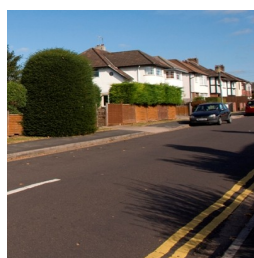
Weeds controlled	Application Rate	Volume of Water	Knapsack Dilution Rate (200 litres/ha water volume)
Annual weeds	1.5 litres	80 - 400 litres water/ha	75ml frontSWEEP in 10 litres water
Perennial grasses and broad-leaved weeds	4 - 5 litres/ha	80 - 400 litres water/ha	200 - 250ml frontSWEEP in 10 litres water

Where can I use frontSWEEP?

frontSWEEP is approved for total weed control in a variety of situations. It is highly effective at controlling grasses, annual and perennial weeds in amenity, industrial and forestry situations.

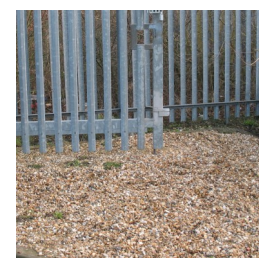
